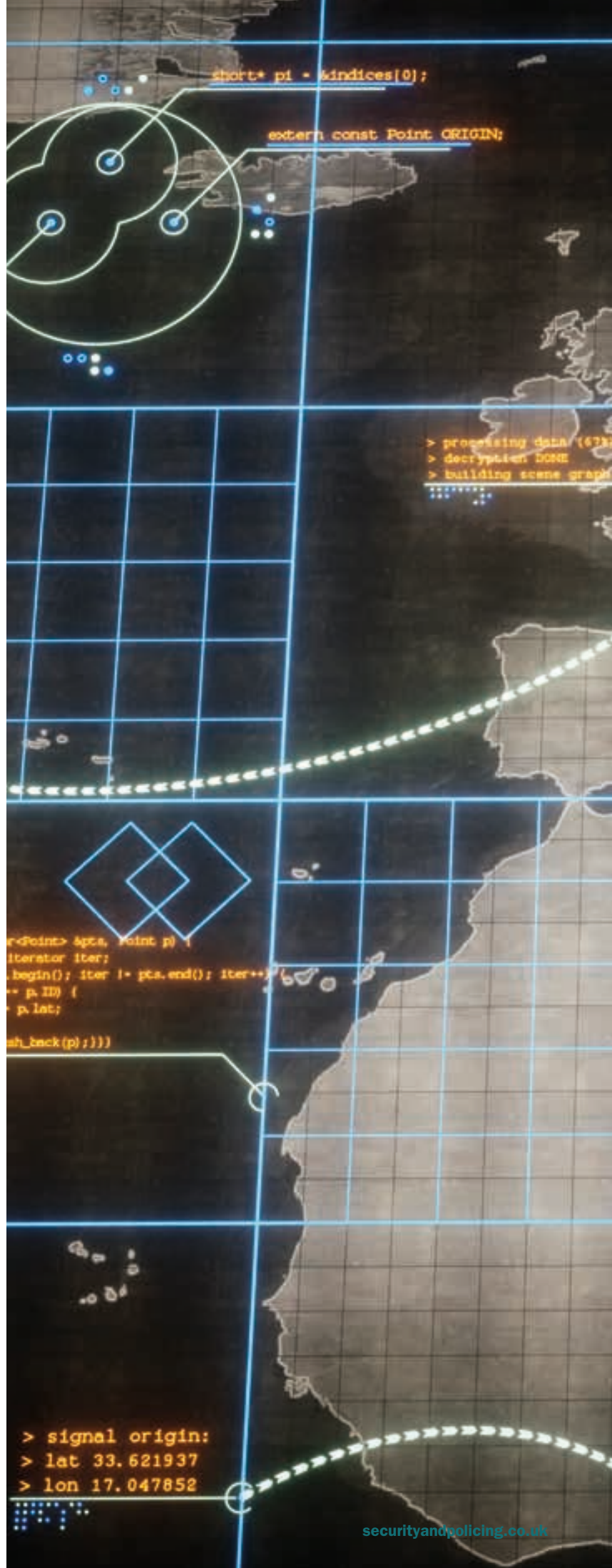
Artemis-UK argues that security lies at the heart of the prosperity of any nation
